



Dinosaur Tail

You will need:

Chicken wire
Tissue paper
PVA glue and water
Paint
Pillow case
Strong white card
Bubble wrap
Double sided sticky tape

Steps:

1. Carefully use the chicken wire to form the shape of a dinosaur's tail.
2. Fill the end of the tail with bubble wrap.
3. Using the PVA glue and water mixture, glue thin layers of material onto the tail.
4. Cut different sized fins from the white card, cutting 2 or 3 slits at the bottom. The slits will make it easier to place the fins onto the tail.
5. Place the largest fins on the wide end of the tail and the smallest fins at the other end.
6. Cover with colourful tissue paper.
7. Paint with dinosaur coloured paint.
8. Place pillow cover in the hole and attach with double sided sticky tape.
9. Do not disturb!!
